

GIFTING OF THE HRUSHEVSKY COLLECTION

Event Recap - 2024

THE EVENT

On February 21, 2024, marking the second anniversary of the Russian Federation's invasion of Ukraine, the Canadian Institute of Ukrainian Studies organized a gifting of 10 sets of Mykhailo Hrushevsky's *History of Ukraine – Rus'* to First Lady of Ukraine Olena Zelenska's Ukrainian Bookshelf Project.

CIUS, in collaboration with the University of Alberta, the Embassy of Canada to Ukraine, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine, the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, and the Kyiv Mohyla Academy made the presentation in the heart of historic Kyiv.

About the Bookshelf Project





Only through access to Hrushevsky's work in an English edition could the international community come to understand the place of Ukraine in world history.

The History of Ukraine-Rus' is the most comprehensive account of the ancient, medieval, and early modern history of the Ukrainian people. Written by **Ukraine's greatest modern historian, Mykhailo Hrushevsky**, History of Ukraine-Rus' remains unsurpassed in its use of sources and literature, even though its last volume was written in the 1930s. In the development of the Ukrainian national movement, it stands as the definitive scholarly statement that Ukrainians constitute a nation with its own historical process.

The English publication of the full *History of Ukraine-Rus'* serves as a basis for understanding the Ukrainian historical process to the mid-seventeenth century, and as a tool for the examination of the thought of the Ukrainian national revival and the views of one of its greatest leaders.

At a time when Putin's Russia is carrying on a genocidal attack on Ukraine and denying that Ukraine has a history and a culture, Hrushevsky's History of Ukraine-Rus' provides an authoritative refutation. The Peter Jacyk Centre for Ukrainian Studies, a unit of the Canadian Institute of Ukrainian Studies at the University of Alberta, has been privileged to make this work that is an example of **the best** Ukrainian scholarship available to international community that seeks to understand the deep roots of Ukraine and the Ukrainian people through the writings of their greatest historian.





OUR GRATITUDE FOR COMMUNITY IMPACT

Hrushevsky's work was banned in the USSR from the 1930s to the end of the 1980s. In 1989, the Peter Jacyk Centre and the Canadian Institute of Ukrainian Studies worked with Ukraine to reprint the *History of Ukraine-Rus*'. In 1991, the 1st volume was republished with **100,000 copies.**

Special gratitute is extended to Nadia Jacyk for her continuing support of this project, as well as to all donors who helped to see all 10 volumes in 12 books translated and fully annotated. This has been years of work for **150 scholars across 13 countries**. The full collection is now available in print through CIUS Press.
