The Master of Education in Educational Studies (MES) is a two-year, parttime, course-based program for teachers, educational administrators, and educational leaders who want to enhance their knowledge and practice in areas of leadership and school improvement.

To optimize the learning experience, the program is cohort-based. Coursework is structured to allow you to build your knowledge in an area of education leadership. The MES provides you with opportunities to develop educational research skills and apply them in your educational context.
