Applicants to some disciplines in the Faculties of Education and Health Sciences will also be required to demonstrate a further level of Spoken English Language Proficiency in addition to ELP.

Scholarships & Awards

The University of Alberta administers more than \$46 million in undergraduate financial support each year, and we have scholarships and awards specifically for international students. uab.ca/awards

Admission-Based

Based on your admission average alone, you could receive awards you don't even have to apply for!

University of Alberta International Admission Scholarship: Students with superior academics in high school may receive a maximum of \$5,000.

Alberta Regional Excellence Scholarship: Students attending high school in Canada on a study permit with an admission average of 80%+ may receive \$4,000 - \$5,000.

Application-Based

Simply fill out one application and we will assess you for eligibility based on experience, background, academics and interests. The deadline to apply is January 10, 2024.

President's International Distinction Scholarship: The University of Alberta's most prestigious and competitive scholarship for international students. Valued at \$120,000 (payable over four years).

University of Alberta International Leader Scholarship: Well-rounded leaders with superior academics may receive \$5,000 - \$10,000.
