

AFNS Graduate Mentor Award

Value: Certificate

Eligibility: The purpose of this award is to recognize a member of the Association of Academic Staff: University of Alberta (AAS:UA), whose work with and for graduate students has been of exceptionally high quality. The Academic Staff Award will be adjudicated on the basis of following criteria. Each criteria will be ranked on a scale of 1-5 (5 being high) and then added to determine the total rank for the nominee.

Award Criteria:

1. Contribution to Graduate Students learning experience: Mentorship Research – providing a quality environment conducive to learning and professional growth of graduate students
2. Letters of Support – minimum two letters of support. One must be from current graduate student(s). Other letters of support from past graduate students and other faculty members.

Application: Nominated by current graduate students. Deadline Date: Last Monday of May each year.

Adjudication Committee: AFNS Graduate Program Committee Graduate Student Reps. Feedback from Graduate Student Administrative Assistant if required.

** No nomination for an award will be made if an outstanding candidate cannot be identified.**
