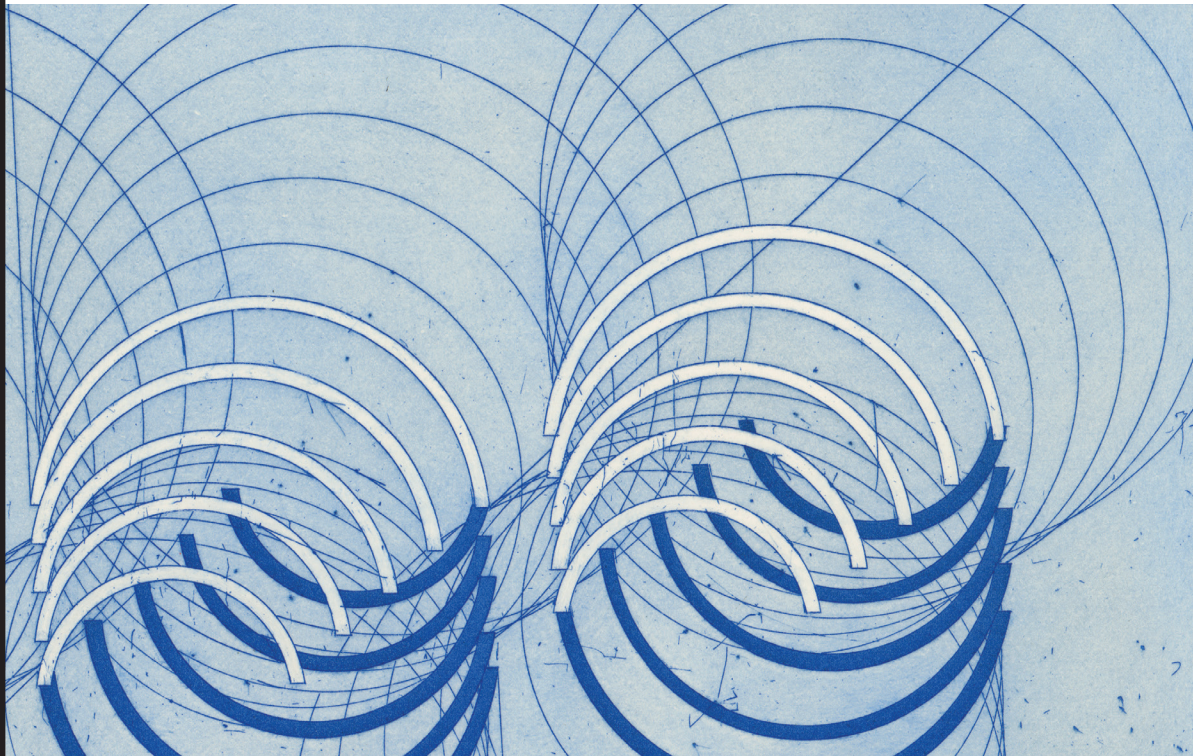


Rachel Duckhouse

Same River Twice

Glasgow based artist Rachel Duckhouse shares her drawing and printmaking practice, and some of the artist residencies that underpin it. Including a year with the Bow River in Calgary, trying to understand solar physicians in Paris, and gathering sheep in the Outer Hebrides.

Rachel Duckhouse is a Glasgow based artist working primarily in pen and ink drawing and etching. Through drawing she explores structures, rhythms and patterns found in different contexts including landscape, architecture and the flow of water. Her work is often made in response to artist residencies, where she explores new landscapes or environments. She's undertaken artist residencies in Canada, Australia, France and Cornwall and has worked on public art commissions including the entrance gates of Edinburgh Printmakers. Her work has been acquired by The British Museum, Great Ormond Street Hospital in London and The Albert Einstein College of Medicine, New York.
