

ARC CARD

Arc is the Edmonton region's electronic fare payment system. It includes an Arc card or a single-use Arc ticket to be tapped when entering and exiting buses and the LRT on seven neighbouring transit systems in Beaumont, Edmonton, Fort Saskatchewan, Leduc, Spruce Grove, St. Albert, and Strathcona County.

New students for the Fall 2024 and Winter 2025 terms can purchase their Arc Card at participating retailers. You can also purchase an Arc card online. New students must register their card on the U-Pass App and have it shipped to your home.

GSA Academic Travel Grants Summary

- Up to \$500 for Masters students during the degree program
- Up to \$1000 for Doctoral students during the degree program (max. \$500 per fiscal year (1 April to 31 March))

GSA Child Care Grants Summary

- For children under 18 years of age
- Max. \$1000 per child per fiscal year (1 April to 31 March)

GSA Emergency Bursaries Summary

- A non-repayable bursary of up to \$4000
- Complete the online application and then make an appointment with the Student Financial Services Office

GSA Graduate Student Group Grants Summary

Funding for seminars, guest lectures, colloquia, start-up funds, and more
