



Camp fyrefly Alberta North Artist in Residence (AIR)

Camp fyrefly Northern Alberta is looking for an artist with the skills, experience, and vision to provide arts-based programming for 2SLGBTQ+ youth online. Camp fyrefly is a summer camp and leadership retreat designed for two-spirit, lesbian, gay, genderqueer, bisexual, trans, queer, questioning, non-binary, pansexual, asexual, and intersex youth (2SLGBTQ+) aged 14-24. Phase 1: Pre-camp Preparation (Approx. 9 Hours)

Phase 2: Training (Approx. 8 Hours)

Phase 3: Camp (Approx. 13 Hours)

Role includes:

- Along with the Camp Coordinator, development and coordination of arts-based programming for Camp fyrefly, which includes:
 - Workshops and asynchronous activities from a variety of disciplines
 - Delivery of content online
- Group facilitation
- Following and ensuring compliance with Community Guidelines

Qualifications:

- Demonstrated commitment to innovation, exploration, and community outreach
- Cultural competency and understanding of 2SLGBTQ+ identities and experiences
- Emerging or established artist
- Experience working with youth
- Interested in and open to using alternative media (both in art and in program delivery)
- Demonstrated leadership experience
- Comfortable learning and using online platforms
- Experience facilitating or leading group art instruction is a strong asset

Honouraria: As a thank you, and in consideration of time you may have to take from work, a \$1500 honouraria is available (approximately \$50 / hour; payable end of month after Camp).

2. Statement of Intent explaining what you would like to accomplish (500 word max)

4. Names and contact information of two references
5. Provide 1-10 portfolio items - Images (up to 5MB each), Video (up to 250MB each), and PDFs (up to 10MB each).
