

GIFTING OF THE HRUSHEVSKY COLLECTION

THE EVENT

On 21 February 2024, marking two years of the Russian Federation's full-scale invasion of Ukraine, the Canadian Institute of Ukrainian Studies gifted 10 sets of Mykhailo Hrushevsky's *History of Ukraine-Rus'* to First Lady of Ukraine Olena Zelenska's "Ukrainian Bookshelf" project.

CIUS, in collaboration with the University of Alberta, the Embassy of Canada to Ukraine, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine, the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, and the National University of Kyiv-Mohyla Academy made the presentation in the heart of historic Kyiv.

About the Bookshelf Project







Only through access to Hrushevsky's work in an English edition could the international community come to understand the place of Ukraine in world history.


The History of Ukraine-Rus', whose last volume was written in the 1930s, is the most comprehensive account of the ancient, medieval, and early modern history of the Ukrainian people. Written by **Ukraine's greatest modern historian**, **Mykhailo Hrushevsky**, History of Ukraine-Rus' remains unsurpassed in its use of sources and literature. In the development of the Ukrainian national movement, it remains as the pre-eminent and definitive scholarly statement that Ukrainians constitute a nation with its own historical process.

The English publication of the full *History of Ukraine-Rus'* serves as a basis for studying Ukrainian history to the mid-seventeenth century and as a tool for examining the thought around Ukrainian national revival and the views of one of its greatest leaders.

At a time when Putin's Russia is maintaining a genocidal attack on Ukraine and denying that Ukraine even has a history and a culture, Hrushevsky's History of Ukraine-Rus' provides an authoritative refutation. The Peter Jacyk Centre for Ukrainian Historical Research, a unit of CIUS based in Toronto, laboured for 3 decades to produce the translated edition as an example of the best Ukrainian scholarship available to the international community, enabling a deeper understanding of the roots of Ukraine and the Ukrainian people through the writings of their greatest historian.



At the Hrushevsky presentation event, a Memorandum of Understanding was concluded between two leading Ukrainian studies institutions — signed by Serhiy Kvit, Rector of the National University of Kyiv-Mohyla Academy, and Natalia Khanenko-Friesen, Director of CIUS — forging a new partnership for future projects.

CONTINUING THE WORK — QUEBEC

On 31 October 2024, Minister of Foreign Affairs of Ukraine **Andrii Sybiha** took part in the ceremony of donating the English edition of Mykhailo Hrushevsky's *History of Ukraine-Rus'* to the **National Library and Archives of Quebec** (BAnQ) as part of First Lady of Ukraine Olena Zelenska's "Ukrainian Bookshelf" project in Canada.

The "Ukrainian Bookshelf" at BAnQ was opened in February 2024 with a set of children's literature in Ukrainian. BAnQ's Ukrainian collection includes more than **350 Ukrainian books** in Ukrainian and French, and now it proudly includes the translated Hrushevsky collection.

OUR GRATITUDE FOR COMMUNITY IMPACT

Hrushevsky's work was banned in the USSR from the 1930s to the end of the 1980s. In 1989, the Peter Jacyk Centre at the Canadian Institute of Ukrainian Studies worked with Ukraine to reprint the original Ukrainian-language edition of the *History of Ukraine-Rus*', starting in 1991 with **100,000 copies** of volume 1.

Special gratitute is extended to the Petro Jacyk Education Foundation and its president, Nadia Jacyk, for their continuing support of this project, as well as to myriad donors who enabled all 10 volumes in 12 books to be translated and fully annotated. This has taken years of work for **150** scholars across 13 countries. The full set is now available in print from CIUS Press. We are also pleased to announce that Volume One of the English-language edition has been digitized and can be accessed through the CIUS Press website.
