Some placements may go into the summer months. Some students may complete placements of differing lengths. Some students complete placements in a different sequence (e.g. thesis track students may complete placements in fall term year three).			

Brief Summaries:

CSD 530: An introduction to clinical practice, counselling, and professional aspects in speech-language pathology from assessment to treatment planning and discharge. The focus will be on clinical and professional foundations, clinical reasoning, and introducing novice-level competencies with opportunities for learning primarily through observation, simulations, or experiential learning activities.

CSD 524: Introductory supervised clinical practice experiences focusing on a variety of clinical populations. The focus will be on developing novice level competencies.

CSD 525: Introductory supervised clinical practice experiences focusing on a variety of clinical populations. The focus will be on developing advanced novice level competencies.

CSD 532: Advanced clinical practicum I. Full-time supervised clinical practicum normally for a period of eight weeks in an approved clinical service. The focus will be on developing intermediate level competencies. Students will have completed all academic course work and will be prepared to learn in the field within the full range of Speech-Language Pathology areas of practice.

CSD 533: Advanced clinical practicum II. Full-time supervised clinical practicum normally for a period of eight weeks in an approved clinical service. The focus will be on developing advanced intermediate level competencies. Students will have completed all academic course work and will be prepared to learn in the field within the full range of Speech-Language Pathology areas of practice.

CSD 540/541: Advanced clinical practicum III/IV. Full-time supervised clinical practicum normally for a period of eight weeks in an approved clinical service. The focus will be on developing entry-to-practice level competencies. Students will have completed all academic course work and will be prepared to learn in the field within the full range of Speech-Language Pathology areas of practice.

Note: Placements can be split within or across sites to allow for part-time CEs to take students.
