2. Campus selection:

Our program is distributed over two campuses. For Fall 2025, within our 97 seat quota, we have available 81 seats at our Edmonton campus and 16 seats at our Augustana campus (Camrose, AB). In the implemented distributed teaching model, both campuses will receive instruction simultaneously, via video at the Augustana campus. There will be instructors located at both campuses with each campus having access to the same educational experience. Re campus selection: **You are not guaranteed your first choice.** If you do not enter a second choice, we will assume that, if you are made an offer of admission to the program, you will only attend the program if you receive your first choice of campus location. Doing this will restrict the number of seats available to you and potentially your offer of admission.

Within our 97 seat quota, 25 seats (at the Edmonton or Augustana campus) are reserved for Saskatchewan (SK) applicants. You must be able to supply an SK healthcare card and be able to complete your external placements in SK (in the second year of the program). If you are an SK applicant but do not wish to apply to the reserved SK seats, you may select No and your application will be processed without SK consideration.

- It is your responsibility to **complete ALL** of the information requested in the table below. Incomplete information may result in your application not being processed.
- **Do not** list more than 1 course in each content area unless a combination of courses was approved as necessary, e.g., ling 101 and 102 to fulfill introductory linguistics.
- **A course may be listed only once** as fulfilling a prerequisite requirement. **Do not** list one course as fulfilling multiple prerequisite requirements. This will result in your application not being processed.
- In the number of credits column, the minimum # of credits should be 3. This may refer to one term, one half-course, or one semester.
- To ensure that the course you listed is appropriate as a prerequisite, you will have consulted the listed institutions on the Prerequisite Courses [webpage](#) and/or have received permission from the department. Please indicate which it is in the Content area column: *On list* or *Approval received* (attach approval email). If you have not done either of these tasks but believe that a course that you have taken does fulfill a requirement, attach the course syllabus for review. If you do not attach a syllabus for an unapproved course, your application will not be processed.
- If a course is *in progress* (IP) at the time of application (a maximum of 2 courses only), enter IP in the grade column and “currently” in the Term and year taken column and attach proof of enrolment.
- **Do not write in any of the columns SEE TRANSCRIPTS.** The entire table must be filled out. If SEE TRANSCRIPTS is written, your application will not be processed.
