CALENDAR DESCRIPTION OF EAST ASIAN STUDIES MAJOR (§44.9.3)

A major in East Asian Studies requires **EASIA 101** and a minimum of ***30** to a maximum of ***48** at the senior level from EASIA, CHINA, JAPAN, or KOREA, including:

***6 in CHINA, JAPAN, KOREA at the senior level including one or more of 302, 401, 402;**

One of CHINA 341, JAPAN 341, KOREA 302;

***12 in EASIA at the senior level, *6 of which must be at the 400 level.**

Related East Asian content courses **may be** taken as **options**, or applied to the major to a **maximum of *9**. These will be in addition to, not in place of, the requirements above. **Note:** The list of related East Asian content courses is available from the Department of East Asian Studies.
