2. Post-Secondary Learning Act (PSLA) : The Board of Governors has authority to employ "officers, employees or other persons and academic
staff members" (Sections 83 and 84 of the Act) and to appoint the
President, Vice-Presidents, Deans and Registrar (Sections 81, 82, 21(1)
and 20(1) of the <i>Act</i>). The Board has delegated certain of these powers.
3. Selection of Faculty Deans Procedure/Review of Faculty Deans
Procedure : Overview: "With respect to the procedures for the selection
[(or) review] of Faculty Deans, the Board and GFC delegate their
approval authority to the GFC Executive Committee for all matters of a
routine editorial nature. For matters of a substantive nature, the GFC
Executive Committee shall recommend to the Board Human Resources
and Compensation Committee (BHRCC). The Provost and Vice-
President (Academic) will determine what is of a routine/editorial nature
or substantive nature
