Table 1 Low Hazard Work

“Low hazard work” means work at:

- (a) administrative sites where the work performed is clerical or administrative in nature;
- (b) dispersal sites
 - (i) where a worker is based,
 - (ii) where a worker is required to report for instruction, and
 - (iii) from which a worker is transported to a work site where the work is performed.

Table 2 High hazard work

“High hazard work” means work involving:

- (a) construction or demolition, including
 - (i) industrial and commercial process facilities,
 - (ii) pipelines and related gas or oil transmission facilities,
 - (iii) commercial, residential and industrial buildings,
 - (iv) roads, highways, bridges and related installations,
 - (v) sewage gathering systems,
 - (vi) utility installations, and
 - (vii) water distribution systems;
- (b) operation and maintenance of
 - (i) food packing or processing plants,
 - (ii) beverage processing plants,
 - (iii) electrical generation and distribution systems,
 - (iv) foundries,
 - (v) industrial heavy equipment repair and service facilities,
 - (vi) sawmills and lumber processing facilities,
 - (vii) machine shops,
 - (viii) metal fabrication shops,
 - (ix) gas, oil and chemical process plants,
 - (x) steel and other base metal processing plants, and
 - (xi) industrial process facilities not elsewhere specified;
- (c) woodlands operations;
- (d) gas and oil well drilling and servicing operations;
- (e) mining and quarrying operations;
- (f) seismic operations;
- (g) detonation of explosives.
