In this talk I will review and clarify current Alberta Health Services (AHS) policy and examine more broadly the practice of patients and families recording clinical staff at work. I will address two questions specifically: *Do I* have the right as a clinician to refuse to have my image recorded while providing patient care? *Should I* have the right to refuse to have my image recorded while providing patient care? Lastly, I will propose a strategy to approach this question that respects both the dignity of staff and the core values of AHS.
