I will explain why I changed from advocating for lockdowns to realizing that lockdowns will cause more harm than benefit. I had only been considering one side of the equation, that is, COVID-19 deaths, while ignoring deaths resulting from our response itself. Updated data on infection fatality rate, age-related risk, herd immunity thresholds, and exit strategies will be presented. An informed cost-benefit analysis will show that the response to COVID-19 will cause far more loss of life and wellbeing than the SARS-CoV-2 can.
