Medical Assistance in Dying (MAID) is legally permissible in Canada, but, as of yet, not broadly accessible to people who are incarcerated. As a nurse practitioner in a correctional setting, I have had the opportunity to provide care to a few patients who were independently assessed (and declined) for MAID. This caused me to contemplate the ethical challenges associated with providing MAID to people who are incarcerated. This presentation opens a preliminary dialogue into this topic area.
