This presentation considers the effect of this year's planned legalization of recreational marijuana on Canada's current medical cannabis system. While ethical debate has focused on whether legalizing recreational use of cannabis is a step forward or a step in the wrong direction, the effect on those who currently benefit from Cannabis treatment has been largely ignored. This presentation argues that Canada's planned legalization will harm those who have legitimate needs for medical cannabis products and undermine the current medical cannabis system.
