Mykhailo Bilas (1924–2016) was a winner of the National Artist of Ukraine award and was known for his artwork in textiles and his vibrant exhibits portraying life of Ukrainian peasants. His colorful art pieces are in museums and private collections throughout Ukraine, USA, Canada, Europe and parts of Asia.
