CRYO2007 Travel Award Term of Reference and Policies

Terms of Reference

The CRYO2007 fund will provide graduate students in the Faculties of Medicine and Dentistry and Engineering with a travel assistance award. All MSc students registered fulltime are eligible to receive one travel award during their graduate program. All PhD students registered fulltime are eligible to receive two travel awards during their graduate program. The amount of each award is set at \$500. When the total pool of money in the CRYO2007 fund is committed, no further applications will be considered.

Funding may be provided for travel to a major national or international research gathering where the student is presenting a paper or poster as the primary author on a topic related to cryopreservation or the preservation sciences.

Policies

- 1. Funds will be issued upon approval of the award. No receipts will be required. However, to apply:
 - a. Proof must be submitted with the application that a submitted oral or poster paper has been accepted for presentation by the conference organizers.
 - b. A copy of the presentation abstract as submitted to the conference must be attached.
 - c. If applicable, attach a copy of the Conference Registration Form outlining the cost of registration and what is included (meals, accommodation, etc.).
- 2. Requests for travel funding must be approved by the student's supervisor.
- 3. Travel Award applications will be routinely managed in the department of Laboratory Medicine and Pathology Graduate Studies office. An annual audit of the process will be undertaken at the end of the calendar year (December) by the Laboratory Medicine & Pathology Awards Committee.
