Scope:	Terms of Reference . Compliance with University policy extends to all members of the University community.

Changes to Terms of Reference are approved by the Dean's Executive Committee; any substantive changes in function or responsibility must also be approved by Faculty Council.

1. PURPOSE

The Faculty Academic Appeals Committee (FAAC) shall consider formal appeals of final grades and/or of decisions regarding adverse academic standing decisions as detailed in Section 5.0¹ of the Faculty of Medicine & Dentistry Academic Appeals Policy for Undergraduate and Graduate Students, and the Faculty of Medicine & Dentistry Academic Appeals Policy for Postgraduate Medical Education Students.

2. **COMPOSITION**

Composition of the FAAC is detailed in Section 5.4 of the Faculty of Medicine & Dentistry Academic Appeals Policy for Undergraduate and Graduate Students, and the Faculty of Medicine & Dentistry Academic Appeals Policy for Postgraduate Medical Education Students.

3. ELECTION PROCEDURES

The election of faculty members to the FAAC shall take place through the Faculty election process in the spring of each year. In all cases the policies cited in the footnote below should be referenced when electing members to the FAAC.
