Overview

The MD Program follows the policies and procedures of the University of Alberta and the academic regulations are outlined in the University of Alberta Calendar under “Admission and Academic Regulations”. This policy ensures that a single standard for advancement and graduation is applied to all medical students regardless of instructional site.

Policy:

Course requirements for the MD degree are listed in the University of Alberta Academic Calendar. In order to receive an MD degree, students must successfully complete all required courses for years 1 through 4 of the MD program as outlined in the Academic Calendar, with satisfactory academic and professional standing as outlined in the Academic Calendar. A single standard for advancement and graduation is applied to all medical students regardless of training sites. Regulations for assessment and advancement for the MD Program are outlined in the University of Alberta Calendar under “Academic Standing and Graduation.”
