Notes:

- 1. Departments must ensure that the composition of the Supervisory Committees is in compliance with GPS <u>Supervisor and Supervisory Committees regulations</u>. Attention should be paid to the qualifications of the Supervisory Committee members as official University of Alberta Examiners (see <u>Size and Composition of Examining Committees</u>) and the degrees held. All supervisory committee members are ex-officio members of examining committees so the supervisory committee must be structured to ensure that valid candidacy and thesis defense committees can be formed (i.e., 50% of examiners must qualify as UofA Examiners; 50% must have a degree equivalent to or greater than that being evaluated).
- 2. MSc supervisory committee membership is tracked at the departmental/program level, not at GPS. However, the same considerations should apply when forming the committee. Also, many MSc students transfer to the PhD so if transfer is a possibility, the supervisory committee should be structured with the PhD regulations in mind.
