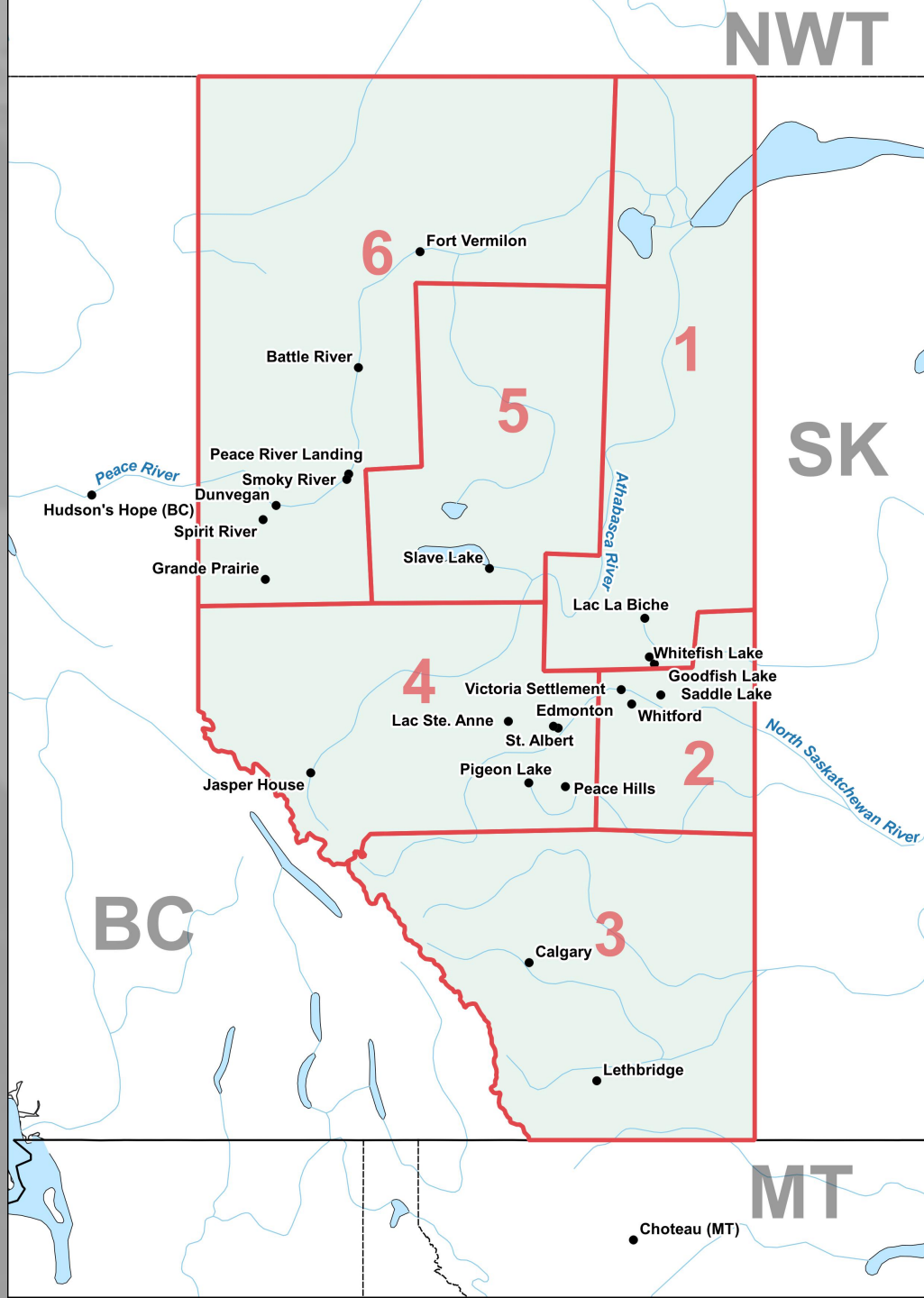
Declaration by Eliza Mackenzie nee LePretre
