Undergraduate Programs

New Undergraduate Programs Curriculum

This 2018-2019 school year saw the first cohort of students for the new curriculum at the Faculty of Nursing. Additional concept mapping for the renewed curriculum occurred during the Winter and Spring 2019 terms.

Clinical Placements

The Faculty of Nursing has five undergraduate programs, which require clinical placements, including a clinical preceptorship during the students' final year. These clinical placements can be categorized as: Acute Care, Child Health, Community, Gerontology, Indigenous, Mental Health, Reproductive Health, Rural, International. During the 2018-2019 Preceptorship Placements, there were 514 Group Placements (eight students per group) and 441 individuals (1 student per placement). In the new curriculum, all students in their final year also do a leadership practicum with field mentors.

Rural Education Initiatives

The Faculty of Nursing (FoN) continues to promote and seek out quality rural clinical placement throughout Alberta. The FoN continues to be supported by the Rural Health Profession Action Plan (RhPaP), which also funds rural nursing and interprofessional rural research via government funding. For the FoN this includes fully funded preceptorship placement accommodation for students during their 350 hour (approximately 12 week) placement and the travel costs for one round trip, similar to what medical students receive in the same program.

In 2018-2019, the rural interprofessional (IP) research team of Drs. Olive Yonge, Deirdre Jackman, and Jill Konkin (from the Faculty of Medicine and Dentistry) partnered with RhPaP to create a digital story research project. Shock Trauma Air Rescue Service (STARS) also provided IP clinician- and student-led simulation days in five rural settings with great success (in attendance, learning, and practice).

NURS 495 Placement in Ghana

There are many highlights from Ghana Winter 2019 and the benefits for our students stand out both on a personal and professional level. Students in this journey view their current nursing practice outside of Global Nursing. Through challenging their cultural biases and their ways of knowing, they soon come to realize that their current nursing practice is not outside of Global nursing and that they need to start thinking about being Global citizens. This transformation of prior learning regarding global nursing, and how the social determinants of health (SDOH) affect access to healthcare was key to the consolidation of this learning within their clinical practice in Ghana. As the students witnessed daily how SDOH affect access to healthcare in Ghana, the integration of concepts of justice, maleficence and beneficence were points of tension and negotiations at bedside when dealing with the financial burden of healthcare on families and healthcare facilities.

Special Projects

The Undergraduate Office has been engaged in a number of special projects to improve the admissions, advisement, and tracking of students throughout their program.

CELCAT: Our Undergraduate Scheduling Coordinator received training on the use of an on-line course scheduling program called CELCAT. In addition to capabilities for timetabling, this program can assist in teaching assignments and room bookings.

Access Database: The Student Advisor, and Admissions and Records Advisors, have been using the Access database. This was developed and implemented as a tool to facilitate tracking and course programming for out of sequence undergraduate students.

Academic Advisement Initiative: The undergraduate office has joined the university-wide initiative to adopt the Academic Advisement Tool. Academic Advisement is a module within Campus Solutions that tracks student progress through their program of study. Academic Advisement allows the configuration of program requirements, transfer credits, course equivalencies and most other exceptions. Through BearTracks, it provides a step-by-step guide for students to plan and review their academic progress. The Faculty of Nursing will join other faculties in the next few months to on-board their advisement activities into the PeopleSoft module.

Holistic Admissions: Following University Governance approval in Fall 2018, steps have been taken toward implementation of the CASPer¹ test as an additional admission requirement, effective Fall 2020 (with admission applications beginning Fall 2019). To date, consultation has occurred with the Registrar's Office and Altus Assessments Inc., the company that manages the testing requirements. Next steps include communication with prospective students and other key stakeholders.

Document Retention and Document Management Initiative: The Undergraduate Office has been working with the University Records Officer to identify document retention requirements and opportunities for streamlining document management, particularly related to student records. With the pending implementation of the University's Slate Admissions system, it becomes more feasible to adopt an on-line student record.

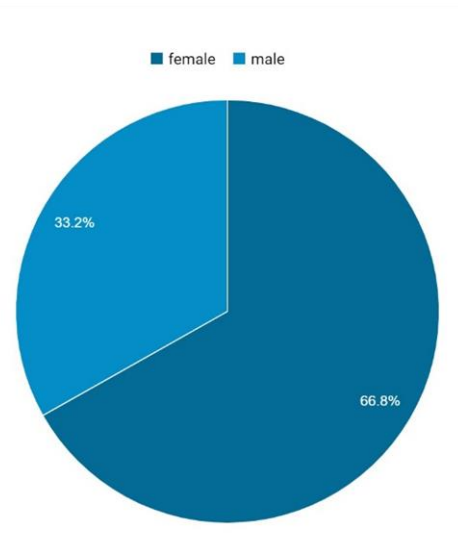
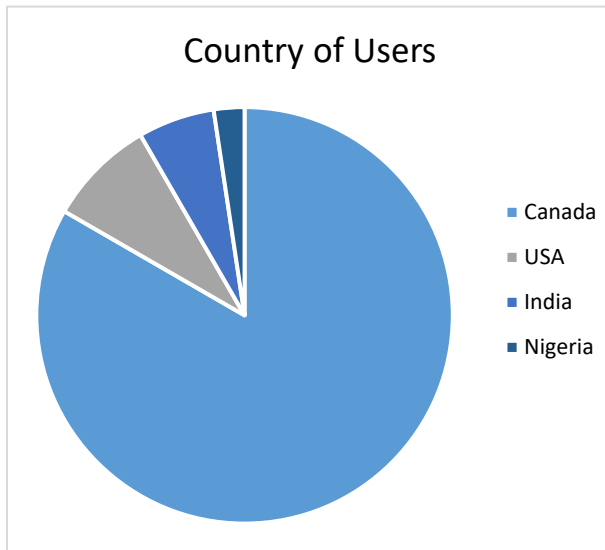

Global Office

International Research

The Global Nursing Office continues to host visitors from partners across the globe. We currently have staff and students representing over 22 countries.

This year, we have welcomed visitors from: Brazil (Universidade de São Paulo, Federal University of Minas Gerais), China (Zhejiang University, Suzhou Vocational Health College), Italy (University of Pavia), the Netherlands (Maastricht University), Spain (Universidad de Navarra, Universitat de Catalunya), Japan (Sapporo Medical University, Yasuda Women's University), Australia (University of Adelaide), South Korea (Yonsei University), Ghana (University of Ghana) and Turkey (University of Kurdistan Hewlêr). Their length of stay varies from two weeks to one year. They worked with our faculty to enhance their area of research.

Ghana Initiatives

In 2019, we hosted six scholars from the School of Nursing and Midwifery, University of Ghana as part of the Canadian Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Scholarships Advanced Scholarship (QES-AS) program. We collaborated on a project called, "Coming Together – Strengthening Partnerships between Ghana and Canada to address Maternal, Newborn and Child Health". Scholars had the opportunity to network at a workshop with project leads, administrators and other scholars at Ryerson University. In 2019, we were able to send two Canadian QES-AS scholars to the University of Ghana to conduct research on maternal, newborn and child health. In the upcoming 2020 year, we are expecting approximately eleven incoming scholars to continue this partnership.

The University of Alberta, Faculty of Nursing, hosted seven Masters of Philosophy in Nursing, students from the University of Ghana to attend Research 900 program. The course was led by Dr. Bukola Salami. This continues to build our partnership to "support and build research capacity...by engaging in graduate student research development and mentorship" (RSCH 900). To conclude their program, the MPhil students engaged in a poster presentation on their research proposal. Dr. Linda Ogilve and representatives from the Ghanaian Friendship Society were in attendance.

Undergraduate Program, Global Health

In 2019, 25 undergraduate students (12 in winter, 13 in fall) went to Ghana for NURS 494/495 final preceptorship. They were recipients of the Queen Elizabeth Diamond Jubilee Scholarship as well as the Go Abroad Group Awards from University of Alberta International. The Global Nursing Office has initiated connections with international sites for the new NURS 425 Leadership course. This course requires 300 hours of field experience.

GNO (FON) was the only faculty awarded by the University of Alberta to compete for the 2019 QES multi-year project proposal, seeking funding of up to \$300,000 CAD. This will support projects in Latin America and the Caribbean that focus on education, social services and health.

GNO was also awarded the Education Abroad Group Scholarship funding for 36 students from undergraduate program for the upcoming 2020/21 academic year.

University of Adelaide, Australia, Global Program

The Global Health Office collaborated with the University of Adelaide on an international Nursing Short-term Program linkage program, which allowed nine students to visit the University of Alberta from February 18 to March 1, 2019. Students attended lectures, nursing simulation lab tours, classroom observation, and site visits. The students also joined and presented in the Western North-Western Region Canadian Association of Schools of Nursing Conference in Edmonton.

Yasuda Women's University

The Global Health Office collaborated with the Faculty of Extension to create the “English for Nursing” English Language and Cultural Seminar. This program is a profit-generating activity for the Faculty, which provides a cohort-based course for undergraduate students majoring in nursing.

From March 18 to 22, 2019, one professor and 19 undergraduate students from Yasuda Women's University in Japan visited the University of Alberta. They participated in the following four nursing components:

- Lectures (Canada: etymology, demographics, government, etc., Introduction to Canadian Healthcare),
- A tour and discussion about the University of Alberta Hospital, Stollery Children's Hospital and Mazankowski Health Center (Health Care Delivery System),
- A tour of the nursing simulation lab, the opportunity to meet with University of Alberta undergraduate students during a lab session, as well as guest speakers from the Graduate Nursing Student Association and Post-Doctoral Scholar from Japan (Undergraduate and Graduate Nursing Curriculum)
- And joining a Department of Music class and attending a rehearsal performance by the Edmonton Symphony Orchestra (Interprofessional Nursing Experience)

Yonsei University, Global Program

The GNO hosted 10 undergraduate nursing students from the College of Nursing at Yonsei University, South Korea, for a 2-week summer course “Understanding of Global Healthcare and Nursing in Canada” offered from July 22 to August 2, 2019. Students enrolled in this program were granted 2 elective credits by Yonsei University. They were able to visit the Royal Alexandra Hospital, University of Alberta Hospital, the Mazankowski Heart Centre, the Alberta Legislature, Norwood Capital Care, the Royal Alberta Museum, and complete visit to the inner city led by the Community Engagement Coordinator of the Mustard Seed. The University of Alberta and Yonsei University continue to partake in the Nursing Short-term Program Agreement that was renewed in April 2018. This program is a profit generating activity for the Faculty of Nursing.

In late 2019, the Global Nursing Office brought forth the Community Cupboard, a non-profit and donation-based initiative to aid any student in need of food or personal hygiene products. The Community Cupboard is supported by the Campus Food Bank and is a year-round initiative.

Social Outreach

The purpose of social outreach initiatives at GNO is to promote capacity building, networking, mentorship and a safe place to emerge friendships with other international visitors and students.

- Pre-Departure Orientation for Undergrad Students going to Ghana: (Ongoing)
Every undergrad group before leaving for Ghana for their Preceptorship, is given the opportunity to partake in a pre-departure cultural and social event with authentic Ghanaian cuisine and a touch of the Ghanaian culture from local Ghanians and scholars.
- University of Ghana Summer Appreciation Lunch: August 2019
The GNO team hosted a lunch at Dr. Solina Richter's residence in honour of the long standing partnership between the University of Alberta Faculty of Nursing & University of Ghana (UG). Two groups from UG (mPhil & QES-AS), along with the Ghanaian Friendship Society were in attendance.
- World Map Wall of Friendship: December 2019
This initiative really brought people from all walks of life together, from UofA Faculties & Staff to Families & Friends.
- Conversation Cafe: December 2019
GNO hosted an end of the year celebration with more than 30 in attendance, representing over 7 different countries.

Teaching and Learning Office

The Teaching and Learning Office (TLO) provides faculty, staff and students with personalized support for teaching and learning in the undergraduate and graduate programs at the Faculty of Nursing. TLO creates digital resources, offers group and one on one sessions on teaching technologies and assessment strategies, and works with faculty to translate their innovative ideas into practice.

Online Student Orientation

This was the second year that TLO implemented an online gamified undergraduate student orientation course. One of our staff members, Jessica Ley, also did a number of presentations for the Orientation Network here at the University of Alberta to share our experiences with other faculties on campus. The response has been overwhelmingly positive and many faculties have plans to adopt the strategies we utilize.

Exam Lock Software

In response to the lack of computer labs for Faculty of Nursing midterms, TLO connected with IST to pilot a new tool that would allow students to write exams on their personal devices in the classroom. Students were given access to the software and a practice exam to ensure their computer was configured properly. The final results of the exam aligned with results from previous years, though many students indicated that they would prefer writing in a computer lab. TLO determined that the large lecture halls were too crowded for this to work well, and for alternative locations to be considered if used in the future.

TLO provided IST with feedback on improvements to the software, which has since been added as a direct result of their feedback. This includes more question-types, auto-updating, more frequent and higher quality evidence, more flexible time extensions, and battery life indication for students.

Indigenous Resources Site

TLO has been working with the Indigenous Nursing Coordinator to create and maintain the Indigenous Resources for Faculty site. This site opened October 2018 and serves as a central repository for Nursing faculty to access key Indigenous resources. These resources encompass everything from “How to Indigenize the Undergraduate Program” to “Understanding a variety of nursing topics” (pregnancy, children, mental health, cardiac and respiratory, palliative, treaty acknowledgement, etc.) using an Indigenous perspective. Ultimately, this site will be of value for anyone who is interested in or responsible for relationship building and engagement with First Nations, Metis, and Inuit people and will directly impact their understanding of Indigenous worldviews in regards to Nursing and healthcare.

Cannabis Education

The Faculty of Nursing recently developed a new revenue-generating course titled, “What Nurses Need to Know About Cannabis Education” which was released Summer of 2019. This was in response to the legalization of recreational cannabis and the many unanswered questions Albertan nurses have as a whole. The course may also serve as professional development for faculty members and has the potential to expand to other areas. TLO facilitated the the curriculum development, project management, and instructional design (interactive elements, online shopping cart, eLearning).

Research Nursing Office

Margaret Scott Wright Research & Innovation Day

The 32nd and final Margaret Scott Wright Research Conference was hosted on November 2, 2018 at the Westin Hotel in Edmonton. The conference theme was “Looking Back with Pride, Looking Forward with Promise”. Professor Tanya McCance from Ulster University was the keynote speaker. Upon conclusion of the day, the Dean Greta Cummings conducted a renaming ceremony and the Faculty of Nursing annual research conference shall henceforth be renamed the Shirley Stinson Nursing Research Conference.

Research Groups

The Faculty of Nursing developed three research groups, the purpose of which was to develop capacity for a focused area of cutting-edge research.

Health Equity

Purpose: build and support research capacity and scholarship for global health, population health, health and social policies, and social justice, with specific considerations of the ways these broad topics intersect with issues of equity, diversity, and inclusion.

Informatics

Purpose: engaging researchers, educators, students, clinicians, and other key stakeholders to work together on informatics-focused research.

Migration

Purpose: build capacity of the Faculty of Nursing, including faculty members, graduate students, undergraduate students, and vital stakeholders to address global issues related to migration and health (born in Canada and internationally).

Endowment Fund for the Future for the Advancement of Scholarship

The Faculty of Nursing received \$30,000 from the Office of Vice-President (Research and Innovation) for the 2018-2019 fiscal year. This funding was allocated to two Small Operating Grants, and two Undergraduate Student Summer Research Awards (out a total of five).

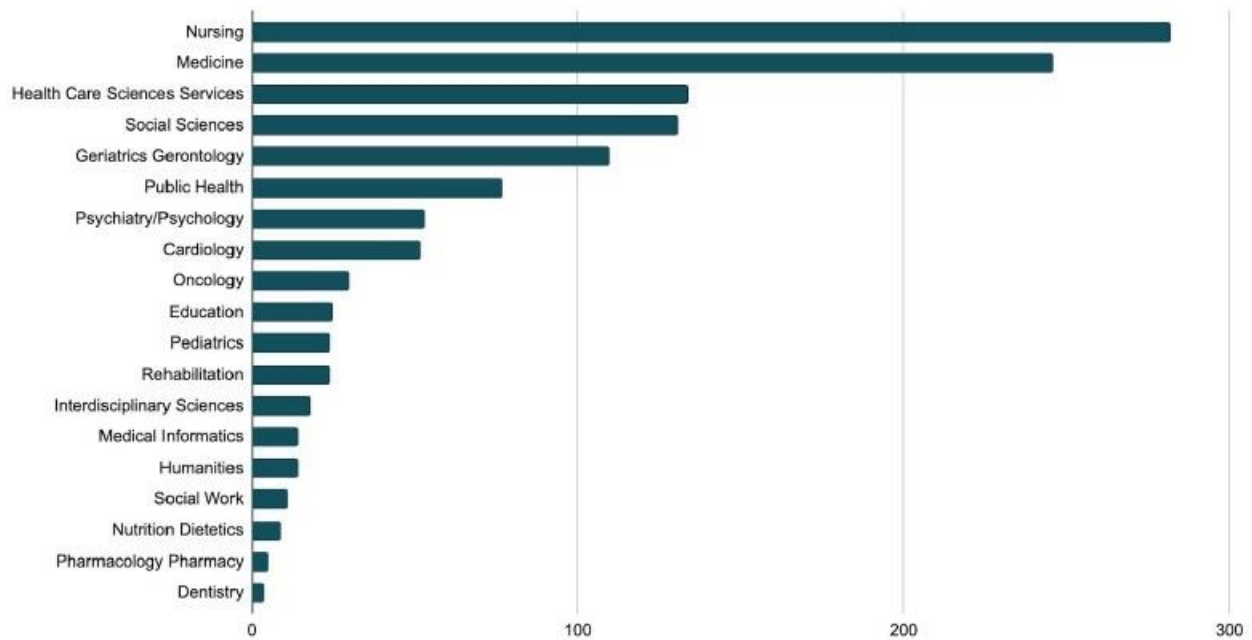


Figure 1 FoN Publications Appear in these Journal Subject Categories.

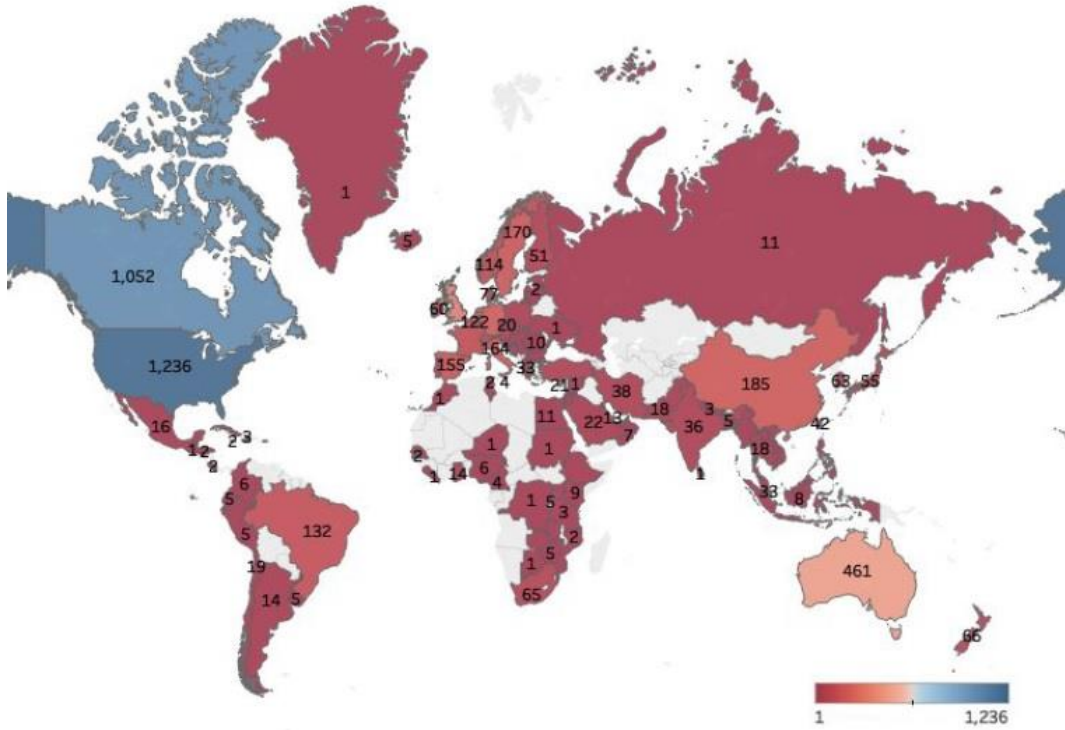


Figure 2. Number of citations per country.

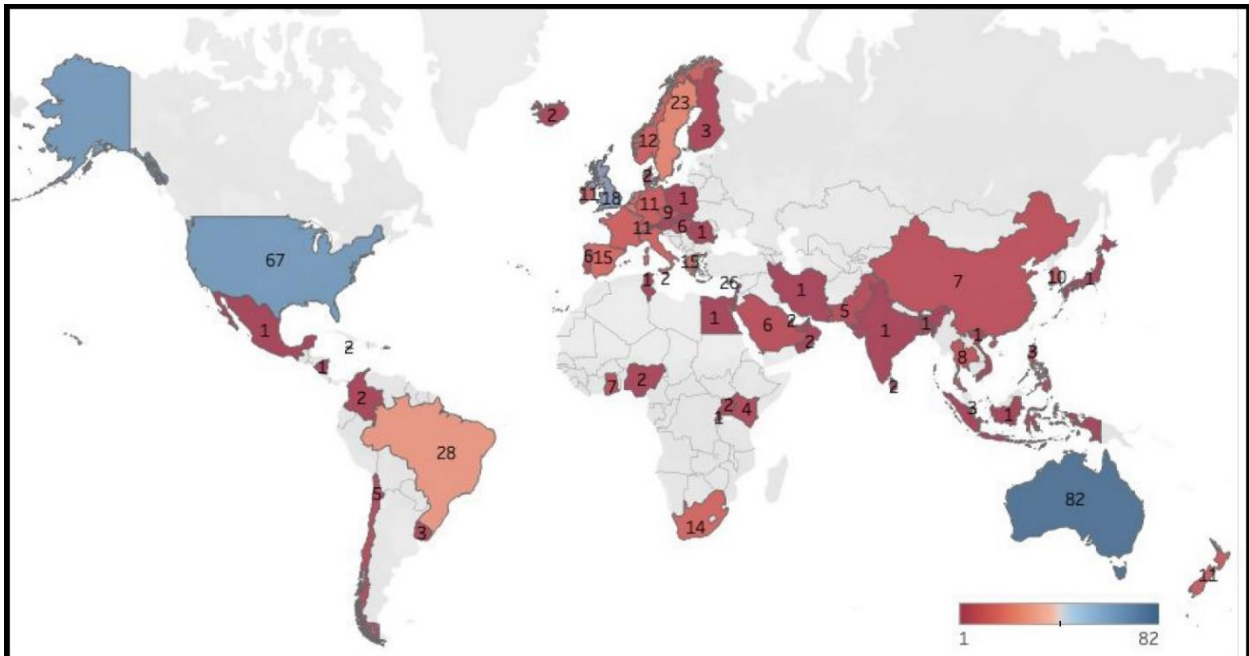


Figure 3. Map of FON international collaboration.
