Obstetrics and Gynecology: Minimally Invasive Surgery (MIS) Rotation Objectives

Welcome to the minimally invasive gynecological surgery rotation. The primary objective of this rotation is to increase resident exposure to advanced laparoscopic and hysteroscopic surgery. However, there are further learning objectives listed below. There are no formal didactic sessions included in this experience, but teaching should occur in the operating room. Your schedule, learning objectives and rotation expectations are included below.

Learning Objectives:

- 1. Demonstrate understanding of fundamentals of laparoscopic surgery
 - a. Pelvic anatomy
 - b. Electro-surgery (including hysteroscopy)
- 2. Complete theoretical portion of SAGES Fundamentals of Laparoscopic Surgery (FLS)
 - a. plan time in CASES to practice for practical exam
 - b. schedule FLS exam (can be completed after this rotation
- 3. Explain below diagnoses, medical and surgical management options
 - a. Uterine fibroids
 - b. Endometriosis
- Understand laparoscopic approach to treatment of pelvic organ prolapse and incontinence.

- 2. Increase exposure of laparoscopic and hysteroscopic gynecologic surgery
- 3. Round on post-operative MIS patients
