

Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)

Students must obtain certification in Health Care Provider cardiopulmonary resuscitation before beginning their clinical placements. Students must maintain their certification by recertifying in each of the subsequent years that they are in the program. All fees and other costs for CPR certification and recertification are the students' responsibility.

CPR courses will normally be organized by the RMSA. However, students are free to obtain their certification at their convenience, and through other recognized organizations as long as the guidelines follow the Heart and Stroke Foundation of Canada recommendations.
