

Out-of-Province Placement Request Information

- Once an out of province (OOP) placement has been requested the student is committed to that request until we have a confirmation (yes or no) from the province. If U of A matches prior to confirmation from another province the student has to wait and will be matched after.
- Once an application has been made for an OOP placement the student is committed to accepting the placement that is offered as long as it is in the geographical area the student was requesting.
- You may request a total of 2 OOP placements.
- You may only request one placement per province/catchment area/year.
- You may only apply to ONE catchment area at a time.
- You may only request a placement in Quebec if you are fluent in French.
- Placements in BC are limited to Student Clinic opportunities at Queen’s Park Care Centre in New Westminster, GF Strong in Vancouver, Surrey Memorial Hospital, Prince Rupert, and Vancouver General Hospital – Eldercare. These placement are only available as per UBC offers so they are not guaranteed.

NOTES: The following universities have approved the implementation of a fee for each placement request. **The fee is non-refundable and does not guarantee a placement will be found.** A cheque made out to the appropriate University should be submitted to Shannon Kowalchuk at the main PT office. If you are a student in Calgary you can give the cheque to Bryce, in Augustana please give to Lisa or Chris and they can forward the cheque onto Shannon.

2. The Capital Health Region in Nova Scotia (including the QE II Hospital in Halifax) will charge a \$75 supervision fee to out-of-province students.
3. Caps exist for BC (a total of 8 requests / year / the entire program) and U of T (will accept a total of 2 requests / year from our program).
