

DR. ROY HIBBS MEMORIAL GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP Application Form

Dr. Roy Hibbs was a geophysics graduate student in the Department of Physics from 1970 – 1977. He received an MSc in 1972 and a PhD. in 1977. His research was in electromagnetic induction in the Earth, and his numerical studies of source effects in two-and three-dimensional problems provided an important early contribution in that field. After graduating from the University of Alberta, Dr. Hibbs held a postdoctoral fellowship at the University of Alberta, Dr. Hibbs held a postdoctoral fellowship at the University of Victoria and subsequently worked in the petroleum industry on projects in Canada, United States and Libya. Dr. Hibbs died in a tragic plane crash in Libya in January 2000.

This scholarship in memory of Dr. Hibbs is to be awarded annually to a student enrolled full-time in a graduate degree program under the supervision of a Faculty Member of the Institute for Geophysical Research. Recipients will be chosen on the basis of strong academic performance with emphasis on research accomplishments at the University of Alberta.
