    - a. successfully completed a Language Other than English at the 30-level (or equivalent), or
    - b. been required to take an English Language Proficiency test for admission
  - ++ Between these four courses (2 Arts and 2 Science) at least \*6 needs to be at the 400-level

+++ You can take more than one variable topics course (PSYCH 302, 305, 403, 405, 421, 423 and 473) so long as they have different topic titles.
