# 11 Academic Schedule 1999/2000

All deadlines in the academic schedule are marked by the ■ symbol. Failure to adhere to these deadlines can result in academic and financial penalty. Application deadlines for undergraduate admissions, readmissions and transfers are summarized in §12 of the University Calendar. Application deadlines for the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research are found in §173.

Please note that the Library may be open on holidays when other University buildings are closed. Students are advised to consult the *Registration Procedures* manual regarding the hours of the Telephone Registration System.
