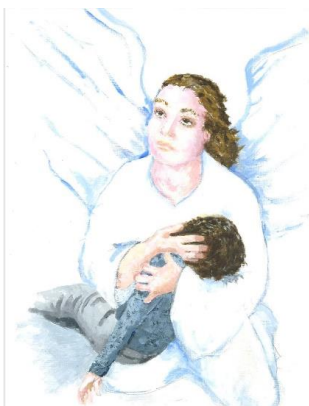
HOPE AND HEALING MASS - OLPH
