### SYNODAL PROCESS BEGINS

Pope Francis has called for a synod of bishops in 2023 on the theme of "For a synodal church: communion, participation and mission." Pope Francis spoke at the formal opening of the synodal process and said "A synod calls on everyone to become experts in 'the art of encounter' in a way that is uplifting and transformative." The Diocesan phase of the process, which runs until April, will focus on listening to and consulting the people of God.

Preaching on last Sunday's gospel (Mark 10:17-30), the encounter with the rich man), the Pope said that we should begin the synodal process "by asking ourselves – all of us, pope, bishops, priests, religious and laity – whether we, the Christian community, embody this 'style' of God, who travels the paths of history and shares in the life of humanity."

### PROOF OF VACCINATION UPDATE

I am still awaiting word on exactly how the University's policy regarding proof of vaccination will apply to the chapel, especially how vaccination status will be verified. The situation right now is that the College is following University policy. The current U of A procedure is to go to ualberta.ca, scroll all the way down to "CAMPUS INFO", click on "COVID-19 Info" right below it, and follow the instructions. You do not need a ualberta.ca email. You will need proof of vaccination in either JPEG or PNG format on your computer or device so you can upload it.

If you have any difficulties (such as being unable to convert the AHS PDF to a picture file) please reach out to me: I want to help. I do think it best if we follow the U of A's policy, but I can't imagine someone ever being turned away from mass because they only have an AHS proof of vaccination. It's a difficult time for all of us – I appreciate your patience and forbearance as we work these issues out.
