It was announced on Wednesday that Pope Francis has accepted an invitation from the Bishops of Canada to visit Canada for a pilgrimage of healing and reconciliation with our Indigenous sisters and brothers. The date of the visit has not been announced.

CATHOLIC SOCIAL SERVICES SUNDAY

Archbishop Richard Smith has recognized Oct. 31 as Catholic Social Services Sunday, commemorating the 60th anniversary of the agency founded by Monsignor Bill Irwin. In addition, the last Sunday of October will be marked as Catholic Social Services Sunday from this day forward.

"Catholic Social Services continues to offer exemplary services to all who need them," said Archbishop Smith. "Whether it is sheltering women fleeing domestic violence, assisting senior citizens suffering abuse, helping parolees successfully transition back into society, supporting new mothers who have nowhere else to turn, keeping the once-homeless permanently housed, providing residential care for adults with developmental disabilities, caring for high-risk youth, or resettling refugees escaping wartorn lands, CSS has been there on the frontlines, faithfully serving all those who need a helping hand in their time of desperation."
