NEW ARTWORK IN KATERI CHAPEL

Changes to our worship spaces are not made lightly or without consultation. Following discussion with the Worship Committee, and after soliciting feedback from the worshipers at the daily mass, an image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus has been placed in the chapel of the Kateri Women's Residence, on the wall behind the tabernacle. The donor wishes to remain anonymous, but I understand the image is from a convent of the Order of the Visitation of Holy Mary, the religious order of Margaret Mary Alacoque, who first popularized the devotion to the Sacred Heart. The focus of the devotion is to soften the image of a harsh God who demands perfection, and add an emphasis on God's mercy and tenderness.

RCIA

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults is how adults become full members of the Roman Catholic Church. The program begins in the fall, and reaches a climax at Easter, when the sacraments of initiation are celebrated. It is for people who have not been baptized before, or who have been baptized in another denomination and wish to become Catholics.
