COLLECTION FOR PAPAL VISIT

On June 18-19 there will be a special collection for Pope Francis' visit to Canada. There will be another collection on July 23-24. Pope Francis will arrive in Canada on July 24. The total cost of the visit is expected to be around \$15 million dollars. This covers such things as lodging and event security for participants; event production costs (e.g. staging, lighting and sound systems); and site logistics (e.g. toilets, power, internet, Wi-Fi, and communications equipment for volunteers).

Archbishop Smith asks that we show our support for Pope Francis' journey and the value and importance of this encounter with the Indigenous Peoples of this land. The organizers are grateful for all gifts, regardless of amount.
