The Outdoor Way of the Cross returns! Hundreds of people, from families with children to students to the homeless will participate in the Outdoor Way of the Cross through downtown Edmonton on Good Friday.

Modelled after the popular Christian devotional that marks Christ's last hours, the Outdoor Way of the Cross started as an <u>Archdiocese of Edmonton</u> event but has grown into a community celebration of prayer and reflection on social justice issues, open to all faith traditions. In its 40th anniversary year, the theme is Care for our Common Home, inspired by Pope Francis' encyclical letter <u>Laudato Si'</u>.

The Outdoor Way of the Cross begins and ends in the inner city, where some of Edmonton's poorest people live.
