HORIZONS OF HOPE: A TOOLKIT FOR CATHOLIC PARISHES ON PALLIATIVE CARE

The Canadian Bishops have made resources available on the subject of end of life care, in particular the Catholic alternative to MAiD. They write:

"As people of faith in Christ, horizons of hope open before us when we gather around the sick and the dying... When confronted with a life-limiting diagnosis, we can find ourselves in an unfamiliar and even frightening situation... We believe in the dignity and sacredness of human life at all stages, from conception to natural death. At the same time, our faith does not demand that life is to be sustained at all costs."

DEVELOPMENT & PEACE/CARITAS CANADA

Honduras's diverse ecosystems, fertile lands and rich natural resources attract many profiteering enterprises that overexploit the land to no benefit for local communities. A minority of very wealthy people control the best agricultural lands on which they grow export- oriented cash crops on an industrial scale. This impoverishes many rural communities, leaving them no means of food production and little power to voice their concerns. Since 2009 Honduras has become one of the most dangerous countries for land defenders.

Development & Peace supports ERIC, Reflection, Research and Communication Team, a Jesuit organization that supports communities in their struggles for land and territory; documents the impact of government policies; and investigates human rights abuses. They also promote freedom of expression and uphold the right to information by using alternative media like community radio to reliably inform people on issues of concern to local communities.
