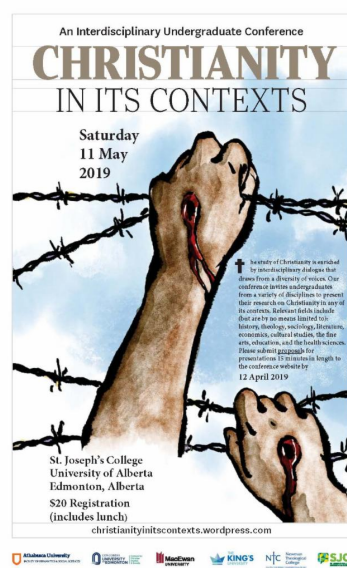
Christianity in its Contexts
