CERTIFICATE IN CATHOLIC EDUCATION

The Certificate in Catholic Education is considered a “hiring asset” for most of Alberta’s Catholic School Districts and increases your ability to get hired in those Districts. This program trains prospective and current educators to work in Alberta’s Catholic education system. All courses are regularly offered in person and online and are TQS-compatible credits. Some districts require two of these courses in order to be hired on a permanent contract.

BA MINOR IN CHRISTIAN THEOLOGY

The Christian Theology Minor is an interdisciplinary program offered by the Faculty of Arts via courses taken at St. Joseph’s College and St. Stephen’s College. Students take 18 credit hours (either St. Joseph’s CHRTC/PHIL or St. Stephen’s SPRIT courses, including 9 credits at the 300- 400 levels).
