GLOBE AND MAIL ARTICLE ABOUT HOD MARSHALL

In an opinion piece in the November 26 edition of the Globe and Mail, Julie Byzcynski reminisces about Basilian Father William Hodgson Marshall CSB. Hod Marshall pleaded guilty to 17 charges of sexual assault of children, but admitted to many more victims before his death on July 28, 2014.

Julie Byczynski was a student at Holy Names High School in Windsor, Ontario when Fr. Marshall was Principal. She remembers being shocked when she read of his guilty plea in June of 2011. "...how was it possible that we didn't see it? How could we not have known?" she asked a friend.

In her concluding paragraphs Julie repeats the questions: "Did I know? Did my teachers know? I don't believe I had any clue, but is that just a convenience of time, of memory? It matters not. All of us are guilty of not questioning, not paying enough attention and not talking. That stops now. That stops here. Thirty years on."

This is why the Called to Protect training program is so vital. It is not because we suspect any volunteer of being a potential abuser. It is so that when a charismatic predator like Fr, Hod walks among us, as many people as possible are trained to see through their tricks.

Please help make Julie's promise true. Make it stop now. Make it stop here. Let's not wait another thirty years.
