## IGNATIAN DISCERNMENT

---

An upcoming faith formation program explores the spiritual discernment exercises developed by Saint Ignatius of Loyola, a 16th Century Catholic priest, theologian and co-founder of the Jesuit religious order. Saint Ignatius' Spiritual Exercises, his methods of discerning and living out the will of God in one's earthly journey, are among his most valuable contributions to Catholic spiritual life.

Starting on Monday, January 13, 2020, the Lighthouse Ministry Team will be hosting An Introduction to Ignatian Discernment, a 14-part series of faith formation studies based upon the Spiritual Exercises. Each session will consist of a video talk and time for discussion and reflection. We hope that you will join us for this time of deep spiritual sharing and fellowship.

**Session Dates:** Mondays on January 13 and 27, February 10 and 24, March 2, 16 and 30, April 20 and May 4, 2020, with sessions continuing in the Fall.
