Mark your calendar: **Tuesday, March 3**, is the annual Day of Confessions in the Archdiocese, a day when our priests devote themselves to celebrating the healing Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation. No matter what the sin or how long it has been since the last confession, you will be welcomed.

Within the Greater Edmonton Area, we have identified six 'hub parishes' where groups of priests will hear confessions from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. on March 3: St. Thomas More, Corpus Christi, Our Lady of Perpetual Help, St. Joseph's Basilica, St. Albert Parish, and St. John Bosco. An employee of MERCY Counselling, a ministry of Catholic Social Services, will be situated at each hub to offer referrals and resources for those dealing with particular vices or mental health issues.
