1 This faculty, once called FGSR, is home to more than 500 graduate programs in 300 research areas, changed its name in October 2023 (abbreviation). (3)

Formerly called the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research (FGSR), the new name, Faculty of Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies (GPS) was approved by the General Faculties Council on Oct. 16, 2023. GPS supports and promotes excellence in graduate education for over 8,400 graduate students in more than 500 graduate programs in 300 research areas

This task force will also contribute to society's broader conversations about the role of artificial intelligence in society's learning environment and bevond.
