

Department Specific Awards

Background Information

Two types:

Departmental – award is restricted to one department; dept forwards nomination to FGSR

Inter-departmental – award open to more than one department; dept forwards nomination to FGSR; adjudication required at FGSR level



What Information must be submitted to FGSR?

Departmental Awards

- *complete and signed nomination form
- *current, unofficial U of A transcript (if newly admitted, last current, official transcript is required if FGSR does not already have such)





Inter-departmental Awards

- *completed and signed Inter-departmental award competition form
- *nomination form (does not have to be completed)
- *an up-to-date cv from the nominee
- *a current, unofficial U of A transcript or current, official trancript <u>if</u> new student and FGSR has not already received such



Best Practices for submitting a Nomination

- 1. Please let FGSR know, in writing, if you have "no nominee"
- 2. Ensure that your departmental statement of support clearly explains why your nominee is a good fit for the award
- 3. Avoid highly technical language, acronyms and jargon.
- 4. Additional documents submitted will not be considered and delays the process; please don't submit such

- 5. Let us know early if you must submit late!
- 6. Ensure that your nominations are in the requisite order and complete
- 7. An up-to-date cv is an absolute must!
- 8. **Tell** us why, in detail, your student is an excellent candidate for this award
- 9. FGSR will send out offer letters to all winners; please do not notify student he/she has won an award before FGSR offers it (sometimes the nominee is ineligible!)

Nominations to be submitted electronically to grad.awards @ualberta.ca (one email please with multiple pdfs) ie 15 pdfs if you have 15 nominations
