

## WELLBEING FACULTY MEMBER AWARD

<b>DONOR:</b>	Not applicable
<b>VALUE:</b>	No monetary value
<b>CRITERIA:</b>	<p>A significant component of a strong residency program is encouragement and fostering of resident well-being. This award is given to an individual who consistently advocates on behalf of residents and resident issues within their role as a teacher/clinician. While many residents can think of staff that fulfill this definition, the following criterion are meant to be a guide to resident nominations.</p> <p>The Pediatrician (general or subspecialty) selected for this award will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• play an active role in seeking out and supporting well being initiatives</li><li>• advocate for residents at both policy and personal levels</li><li>• demonstrate kindness, empathy and respect toward resident concerns in both personal and professional domains</li><li>• display an understanding for the challenges that are experienced in residency</li><li>• provide mentorship and guidance to help residents look after their own well being</li></ul>
<b>DEADLINE:</b>	The first nomination is in April and second nomination will be sent out if less than half of the resident group haven't responded.

Awards will be distributed at the annual Departmental Farewell in the spring of each academic year.
