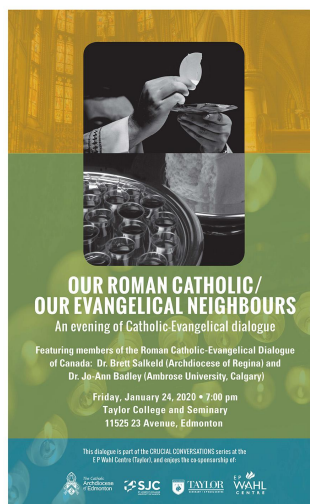
## Catholic-Evangelical Dialogue

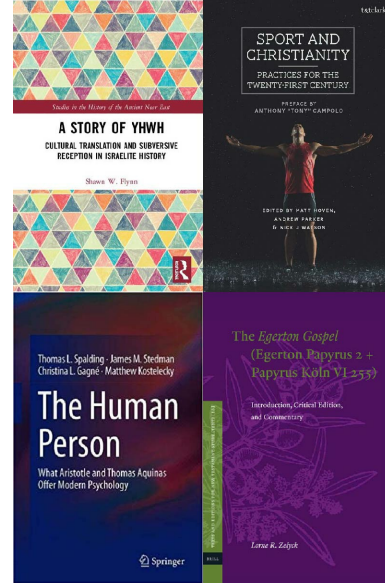
